This hire vehicle represents in our view a best in class value, practicality and comfort offering. We guarantee you will love your rental experience!

Here are some of the many features

This vehicle has 5 Berths (see plan). The over cab bed is permanent, the 2nd double bed is formed by folding the dining table if required and the third is formed by using the lounge sofa. Mattress protectors are provided and these are laundered between hires.

Vehicle dimensions are;  
Length: 5.53 m  
Width: 2.0 m (+ mirrors!)  
Height: 3.0 m

The kitchen area contains cupboard storage, a double gas hob, a microwave and basin with hot and cold running water. There is a fridge with freezer box that is powered either by gas or electricity. The microwave requires an electrical hookup to operate.

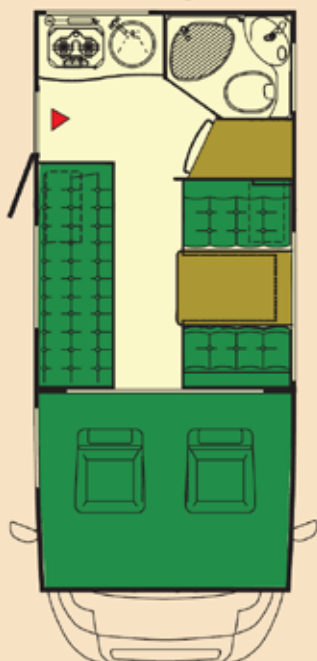
There are two on-board gas bottles supplied and we charge by the kilo (around £3 per kg). A week in the summer will cost about £10 (say) and a week in the winter around £30. You may have to swap bottles if you use more than 2. This is a simple process and can be done at most fuel stations.

The bathroom contains a WC (the cassette has to be emptied periodically!), basin and shower both with hot and cold running water. The WC cassette is emptied into a normal toilet (or special waste point present at most campsites).

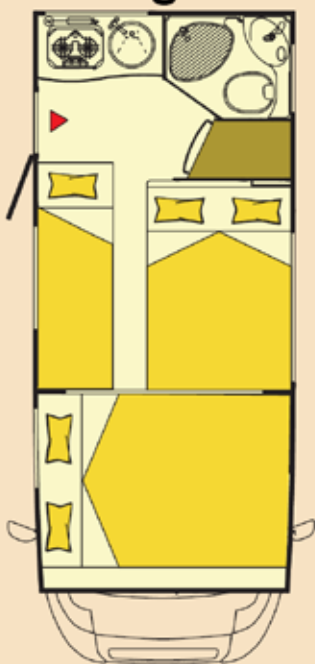
There is a grey water tank (large) for used water. This can be emptied at most campsites or indeed into the ground if you use bio-friendly detergents.

There are five seat belts – 2 'up front' and three at the table. It is normal for up to four passengers to sit at the table. The

rearward facing seat belts are lap-belts only. This is in compliance with current European law which requires all passengers to be wearing seat belts.

There is ample storage including a tall cupboard and eight overhead cupboards. There is also a storage bay external to the vehicle that is about 2m long by 350mm high by 450mm deep. This is about 30% full with supplied equipment such as hook ups, chairs, table and levelling ramps.

There is central heating that is powered by gas.

The water heater is again powered by gas and is a rapid response unit. It has capacity for a 4-5 minute shower and recovers within 20 minutes.

The water tank holds about 90l which is enough for a day or two of washing and showering. Sensible use is advised to minimise consumption and 20 minute showers definitely don't work!

The internal lights and water pump work from auxiliary battery power (not the main battery). Other electrical items such as the fridge (can use gas) and microwave require a hookup. For those choosing the option of a TV pack, there is an on-board power inverter so that you can continue to watch even without a hookup.

Contents:

As a summary, we provide the following;

- All normal kitchen ware (plates, bowls, cups, pans, cutlery, corkscrews etc etc.)
- Washing up liquid and other cleaners.
- Tea towels and dish-cloths.

We also provide non-kitchen accessories as follows;

- Tables and chairs (4)
- First aid box
- Fire extinguishers
- Warning triangle
- Hookup cable
- Hose pipe (for filling tanks)
- Toilet paper
- Coat hangers
- A small selection of games
- A battery lantern
- Spare bulbs and fuses and the like
- A small number of tools
- Levelling ramps





This vehicle has an optional bike rack.

Breakdown cover is provided (the card is in the glove box) and this allows for roadside repair and/or recovery to base.

Extras:

Bedding is not provided unless you order it at a charge of £25 per double, £20 per single per trip.

Other extras are;

- Gas Barbeque is £25 + gas (minimal) per week
- GPS is £20 per week
- Bikes (modern mountain bikes) are £25 per bike per week
- Insurance is £35 per additional driver (1 driver is included in the price)
- TV / DVD pack: £45 for a 24" plasma, DVD and selection of films. This unit will play digital movies



as well and has a USB port if you want to bring your own.

User terms / insurance details:

Normal hire is 3pm pickup, 11am return. Charges are levied per night not per day. It might be possible to vary pickup and return times by prior agreement although we often have end to end bookings and your return time in this regard is critical.

We expect you apply best endeavour in the care of the vehicle and to bring the vehicle back (virtually) as clean as you received it internally. There is no need to wash the exterior.

You are respectfully asked to use the mattress protectors for your comfort and the comfort of future users.





The vehicle insurance requires that you have held for at least 1 year and current hold a EU photo license valid in the UK.

You must also have an endorsement / counterpart sheet that shows your convictions.

Age requirement: 25 – 70 yrs only.

Accident status: No more than one accident as a driver in the last three years.

Employment status: Fully employed or demonstrably self employed, not a jockey, not connected with racing of any sort, not a professional entertainer, not a foreign service employee.

Insurance history: Not been declined, not had refusal to renew, not had special terms imposed as a result of claims.



Mental and physical defects: None.

The Insured vehicle shall not be used for the carriage of goods of an explosive, dangerous or hazardous nature or for the carriage of goods or passengers for hire and reward or any other form of profit or remuneration.

The insured vehicle shall be driven only by the Hirer or other permitted driver who has completed and signed a Hirer's Proposal Form immediately prior to any hiring.

Undergraduates and/or students under 25 years of age are also excluded.

The spirit of the hire agreement is that you are responsible for the first £500 of any and all damage (unless directly caused by an equipment failure beyond your control). Your responsibility ends at this point unless you are negligent or criminal in your actions/intentions and this is determined by the insurance claim process more than by us. You will be provided with insurance details in full and these take precedence over the above which is only intended as a useful guide.

Requirements for identity. There is an increasing incidence of vehicle theft by hirers. Our insurance company therefore require considerable vigilance on our part to avoid this.

**IMPORTANT:** You must send us at the time of booking, the following;

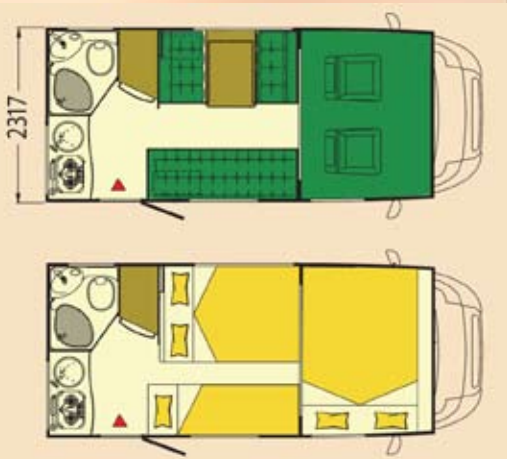
- Proof of address (an original utility bill but not a mobile phone bill) for all drivers
- A copy of both parts of your driving license for all drivers
- Proof of employment
- A copy of your passport (for each driver)

Collection:

Our Newbury depot is not manned so you must call ahead to coordinate your arrival and to be met at the facility. You can leave your car with us. It will be in a locked compound and it will remain completely at your risk.

You must also bring with you at the time of collection

- An original driving license and counterpart driving license for each driver.
- Your passport (for each driver). We will hold this





securely for your return.

Payment terms:

Normal terms are 20% holding fee at the time of booking and the balance within four weeks of departure. Once committed (once you have paid your holding fee), you are fully contracted to these amounts as they become due so please be sure before you book.

A £500 damage deposit (refundable within 5 working days if there is no damage) is due in cleared funds prior to departure.

We can accept most forms of payment including credit cards, debit cards, cheque, BACS and PayPal.

You will be asked to sign the motor home rental agreement prior to departure.

We will supply the following documents with your booking confirmation:

- How to find us
- Insurance policy key facts
- Sample hire agreement
- Terms and conditions of hire

The following will be provided at the commencement of hire

- Motor home user manual (to complement training)
- Full insurance details
- Actual Hire agreement (to sign)
- Terms of conditions of hire (to sign)
- Damage and inventory reports (to sign)
